This new proposal is all-inclusive and would affect all operations of the Knollwood Fire Department. The proposal has many moving parts and will affect property taxes, service response times, and general fire service as residents have known it for the last 50 years.

Chief Richard Carani of the Libertyville Fire Department has been asked to provide a presentation to the residents, explain their proposal, and answer questions from the residents.
